


Online Measuring Template

his guide along side the "How to measure your kitchen" video (www.frugalkitchensonline.com) will give you step-by-step instructions on how to measure and create a floor plan (aerial view) of your space. this information will provide our designers with everything they need. See measuring example below.

STEP 1: Gather your supplies


- ☐ Tape Measure
- Pencil or Pen
- ☐ Copy of Measuring Template

STEP 2: Complete Contact and Necessary Job Information

STEP 3: Measure Your Space


- ☐ Start on the left and sketch out each wall on the floor plan.
- □ Number each wall.
- ☐ Starting in the left corner, measure each wall in the space that will contain cabinets and record those measurements (in inches) on your template.





STEP 4: Room Openings, Doors, Windows


- ☐ Place room openings, doors, and windows on the template (shown in red below).
- Record and number each door, window and room opening on the template.
- ☐ Measure room openings, doors, and windows (including casing) as shown below and record on the template.





STEP 5: Obstacles


- ☐ Draw in any outlets, light switches, air vents, gas lines and water lines.
- ☐ Measure from a corner of a wall to where the obstacle starts and mark that on the template.





STEP 6: Appliances


- ☐ Place all appliances on your floor plan in your desired location. If your getting new appliances, please record estimated sizes.
- ☐ Measure from the corner of a wall to the center of the appliance and mark that measurement on the template, as shown in red below.





STEP 7: Ceiling Height

- ☐ Please measure your ceiling height in three different spots and record the smallest number.
- If your home has soffits over the cabinets, please measure the soffit starting at the ceiling, measuring down to the top of the upper cabinet. If the soffits are being removed, this step is not necessary.



STEP 8: Photos

☐ Take photos from a variety of angles in front of your cabinets and send those photos too. The photos will help the designer understand your space and help with any questions that arise regarding measurements.
